GENERAL INFORMATION FOR VACATION CARE

PLEASE READ BELOW Vacation Care general information (Booking or cancellations polices etc)

Please send your child with LUNCH, RECESS and DRINKS: The service provides a nutritional breakfast (7am-8am) and a nutritional snack, and a selection of fruit and vegetables in the afternoon.

Water is provided but children are encouraged to bring their own water bottle each day.

We have children attending our service who have been diagnosed as a risk of anaphylaxis to nuts. Children and staff are not permitted to bring nuts or any products that contain nuts.

<u>ENROLMENT:</u> All children must be enrolled in our service through the Xplor System. New families must register on MyGov if they wish to claim the childcare subsidy.

BOOKINGS: All outstanding OSHC fees must be up to date by the end of term, otherwise Vacation Care bookings will not be accepted.

Vacation Care bookings MUST be made via the Xplor app. Bookings will be accepted unless there are no further vacancies available. All Vacation Care bookings must be made by 01/04/2024.

Any bookings made after this date will be charged at the casual rate of \$71.

<u>Cancelation Policy</u>: Our Vacation Care Service requires 2 working days' notice to cancel a Vacation Care booking or a relevant doctor's certificate must be supplied to the service. Without a medical certificate for an absence or if a booking has been cancelled with less than 2 working days' notice, then you will be charged as normal for the booking.

<u>FEES</u>: Vacation Care fees are \$66 per day, per child Bookings made after the booking closure date, of 01/04/2024 will be charged at the casual rate of \$71.

<u>PAYMENTS:</u> Will be deducted a week in advance via bank institute of your choice, direct debit will be set up via xplor. If you prefer to pay into our account, please do so prior to automated direct debit date.

When paying by EFT ensure to write 'VACATION CARE FEES' and include your child's full name in the description. We do not accept cash.

SIGNING IN / SIGNING OUT PROCEDURES

- Children must be escorted into the service and signed in and/or out on the iPad by an authorised person. Please inform staff when arriving and leaving.
- The authorised person must be over the age of 18 years and on the child's enrolment form.
- Please send a message via Seesaw or phone if there will be another person picking up your child/ren.
- Authorised person picking up the child must bring photo ID.

<u>ELECTRONICS AND TOYS</u>: It is preferred that children do not bring their own toys from home unless we have planned it into the program. Electronic items such as mobile phones must be handed in for safekeeping. Smart watches must be placed in *school mode* during the service hours.

<u>CLOTHING AND PERSONAL BELONGINGS:</u> Clearly label all clothing and personal belongings. Ensure the clothing your children wear is SunSmart and appropriate for planned activities and covers your child's shoulders. <u>No singlets</u> or <u>tank tops</u> as these are not considered SunSmart clothing. Please make sure your child wears appropriate footwear for planned activities. Enclosed footwear such as sneakers or sandals with back straps are acceptable. We recommend packing a spare change of clothing.

Please note: Our service has a maximum of 60 children and a maximum of 45 for planned excursions.
