Hot and wet weather policy

HOT WEATHER:

When the temperature is forecast to be 36 degrees or above, the admin staff will check the BOM (Bureau of Meteorology) website for the temperature of the suburb, Allenby Gardens, before recess and lunch. If the temperature is 36 degrees or above we will implement the following procedure.

The inclement weather bell will ring (3 short bursts) indicating to all staff and students that changes to play will occur.

Students will remain in their classrooms to play supervised by a teacher.

The canteen will operate from 12:45pm-1:10pm, children may visit the canteen to purchase items during this time.

WET WEATHER:

The inclement weather bell will ring (3 short bursts) indicating to all staff and students that changes to play will occur.

Students will remain in their classrooms to play supervised by a teacher.

The inclement weather bell will ring if the rain clears and leadership deem it safe for children to play outside.
