

Hot and wet weather policy

Hot Weather

When the temperature is forecast to be 36 degrees or above, the admin staff will check the Bureau of Meteorology website for the temperature of the suburb, Allenby Gardens, before recess and lunch. If the temperature is 36 degrees or above we will implement the following procedure:

The inclement weather bell will ring (3 short bursts) indicating to all staff and students that inside play will occur.

Students will remain in classrooms to play supervised by a teacher. Leaders will assist where possible.

The canteen will operate from 12:45pm-1:25pm, children may visit the canteen to purchase items during this time.

Wet Weather

Leadership and/or a front office staff member will determine the severity of the wet weather outside and using the Bureau of Meteorology rain radar. If required, the inclement weather bell will ring (3 short bursts) indicating to all staff and students that inside play will occur.

Students and staff will move to their classrooms and remain in their classrooms to play supervised by a teacher. Leaders will assist where possible.

The inclement weather bell will ring again if the rain clears and leadership/admin deem it safe for children to play outside. Yard duty teachers will then return/begin their designated duties.
